The program

This comprehensive hands-on program will focus on fire suppression operations in a large and complex structures. Whether the objective is searching for life, fire, a downed firefighter or advancing a hose line deep into one of these structures, one thing is for sure; *the operations will be manpower intensive and very dangerous.*

Firefighters must realize this low frequency, extremely high risk event differs greatly from a "bread and butter" room and contents fire. A fire in a large building can be difficult and fast spreading. Whether it's in a family business in rural America or a mega mall in a big city, sooner or later you will have an incident in one of these structures.

Firefighters will gain an appreciation for a strong command presence, knowledge of large area search procedures and the realization that an incident in a large/complex structure can become a firefighter's nightmare. Following an interactive lecture demonstrating "best practices" this program will transition to the field for a series of intense, challenging exercises. This program is appropriate for the new firefighter or company officer.
